A1—Box Stock - Includes Factory Stock, Street Stock, Street Rods 1948 & older, Street Machines 1949 & newer built straight from the box *

A2—Factory Stock - Open

A3—Street Rods - Open (1948 & Older)

A4—Street Machines - Open (1949 & Newer) (Includes Pro-Street)

A5—Customs & Lowriders

A6—Pick-Ups, Vans & 4x4's (Except Racing Vehicles)

A7—Commercial - (Big Rigs, Flatbeds, Construction Equipment, Wreckers, etc.)

A8—Motorcycles

A9—Straight Line Racing - Any racing vehicle that competes on a straight line course (pavement or dirt)

A10—Road Course Racing - Any racing vehicle that competes on a road racing course (pavement or dirt)

A11—Circle Track Racing - Any racing vehicle that competes on a circle track (pavement or dirt)
